*These are topics we are looking to cover but the exact week may change due to guest speaker availability.

Class will begin with a 5 question quiz based on previous week's topic. Students will grade each other's quiz and any follow up conversation based on that topic will take place before introducing the new topic.

*Each week students will

1 -- make 2 informational posters for that week's topic.

2 -- will find one current event article based on that week's topic and write one paragraph response to it.

The semester will culminate in class presentations. Each student will give a 5-7 min presentation based on topic of their choosing. Topic can be chosen from ones we are doing in class, but will need to present new information. If students want to pair up they will need to do an 8 -10 min presentation. Topics could include: personal identity, video games, on line dating, specific sport, college campus, wilderness survival, job related issues, active shooter, camping, large city, farming... Topics will be chosen during class time so that there are no overlaps.

More information on all assignments will be given during the first class. No assignment due for first week.
