

STUDIO ART - OVERVIEW

STUDIO ART IS FOR THE SERIOUS ART STUDENT WHO WISHES TO LEARN MORE ABOUT ART THAN THE PREVIOUS CLASS, LEARNING A NEW SKILL IN THE FORM OF OIL PAINTING. OIL PAINTING DOMINATES THIS CLASS, BUT THERE ARE PEN & INK AND COLORED PENCIL PROJECTS ALSO. IF THE STUDENT DECIDES TO GO TO ART SCHOOL AFTER GRADUATION, CONCEPTS SUCH AS UNDERPAINTING, LAYERING OF COLORS, AND GLAZING WILL NOT BE UNFAMILIAR TERMS. THE UPPER LEVEL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT WHO TAKES THIS COURSE EMERGES FROM IT WITH A KNOWLEDGE OF PAINTING COMPARABLE TO A SOPHOMORE IN MOST ART SCHOOLS. MANY PARENTS HAVE COMMENTED ON HOW MUCH THEIR STUDENT LEARNED IN THIS COURSE.

FALL SEMESTER UPPER LEVEL CLASS

CLASS PROJECT NO. 1 "INTRODUCTION TO OIL PAINTING"

DESCRIPTION: OIL PAINTING IS A NEW SKILL TO MOST HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL ART STUDENTS. EACH STUDENT WILL CREATE AN OIL PAINTING ON CANVAS. INSTRUCTOR DEMONSTRATES.

PROJECT DURATION: FIVE (5) CLASS PERIODS.

THIS CLASS PROJECT WILL ALSO HAVE A HOMEWORK ASSIGNMENT "ONLY GOD CAN MAKE A TREE" TO BE DONE IN COLORED PENCIL. PROJECT WILL BE DUE AT CONCLUSION OF CLASS PROJECT NO. 1.

CLASS PROJECT NO. 2 "ADVANCING MY OIL PAINTING SKILLS - PAINTING THE WAY OF THE MASTERS."

DESCRIPTION: THIS PROJECT TEACHES ADVANCED OIL PAINTING SKILLS SUCH AS UNDERPAINTING, LAYERING OF COLORS, AND GLAZING, EACH STUDENT WILL CREATE AN OIL PAINTING USING THESE TECHNIQUES. INSTRUCTOR DEMONSTRATES.

PROJECT DURATION: SIX TO SEVEN CLASS PERIODS.

CLASS PROJECT NO. 2 WILL HAVE A HOMEWORK ASSIGNMENT "POLITICAL CARTOON IN PEN & INK." PROJECT WILL BE DUE FIRST CLASS IN NOVEMBER, 2018. INSTRUCTOR WILL INTRODUCE/DEMONSTRATE A BIT ABOUT THIS PROJECT AT START OF CLASS PROJECT NO. 2. INSTRUCTOR DOES NOT PROJECT HIS OWN POLITICAL OPINIONS OR ENDOSE A CERTAIN POLITICAL VIEW TO THE POLITICAL CARTOON PROJECT.

CLASS PROJECT NO. 3 "DESIGN AND CREATE A CHRISTMAS CARD" MIXED MEDIA.

DESCRIPTION: EACH STUDENT WILL CREATE A CHRISTMAS CARD. SUGGESTED MEDIA: COLORED PENCIL, INK, FELT-TIP MARKERS (MARKERS PROVIDED BY INSTRUCTOR.)

PROJECT DURATION: TWO TO THREE CLASS PERIODS PLUS HOMEWORK TIME. THERE WILL BE NO ADDITIONAL HOMEWORK DURING THIS CLASS PROJECT.
