World History Assignments

Weekly: Do assigned reading and write out vocabulary answers. They should be neatly typed or written on a regular size sheet of paper with no ragged edges. Answer in complete sentences using proper grammar and including **the time period, the location, and significance.**

Example: Ramses II was an Egyptian pharaoh that lived around 1200 BCE and ruled during the time of the Exodus of the Israelites.

Grade: These assignments get a grade of 10/10 if they are done in this manner and they are handed in at the beginning of the class.

Tests: There will be two tests each semester. They are not cumulative. 100/100

Reports/Presentations:

You will be assigned a topic for a research paper and presentation.

- a. The papers should be 2-4 pages, typed Times New Roman or Calibri 11pt., double-spaced
- b. Use at least 3 sources, but not blogs or Wikipedia, that are listed as the Bibliography as a final separate page of the paper (for those that know how to do Works Cited, you may use that format, but it is not required)
- c. On your assigned day bring the paper to class and be prepared to present your topic
- d. The fall paper will be on a person or an invention that had world impact from the beginning of time to the Renaissance. The spring paper will be on a person or an invention that had world impact from the time of the Reformation to the present. Both papers should give the history of the person/invention, some highlights of their country at the time, what impact they had, and a project that represents your topic
